

How to Give Your Cat a FELIMAZOLE Coated Tablet

Firmly grasp your cat's head with your thumb and forefinger on the side ridges of its face, just behind its jaw. (The cat's cheekbones provide a convenient handle by which to hold the head firmly without causing any discomfort.) Gently tilt your cat's head back so that the eyes are facing upward and the nose is pointed toward the ceiling.

Force your cat to "open wide" by applying gentle pressure at the corners of its mouth. Place the pill as far back in the mouth as possible, targeting the v-shaped area at the back of the throat. Although FELIMAZOLE Coated Tablets are small and easy to swallow, it may help to administer a very small amount of water with a medicine dropper or syringe after administering the pill.

Close your cat's mouth and hold it closed. Gently and briefly rub your cat's nose, or blow on it. This should stimulate your cat to lick its nose, causing it to swallow. Once finished, be sure to reward your cat with praise. Spend time petting your cat or playing with a favorite toy. You can even give your cat a treat. By reinforcing positive feelings, you'll turn the pill-taking process into a rewarding experience for both of you.
